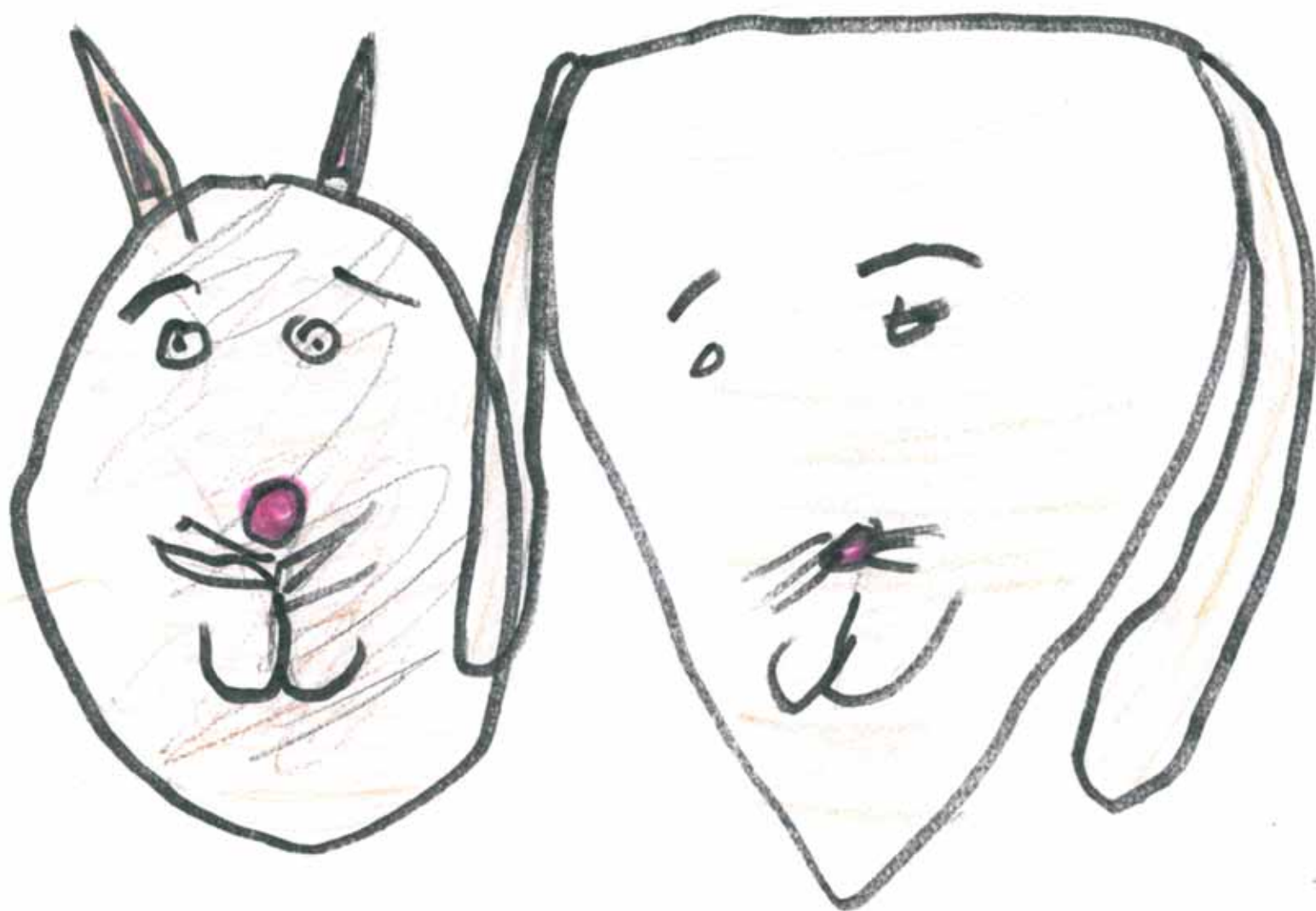

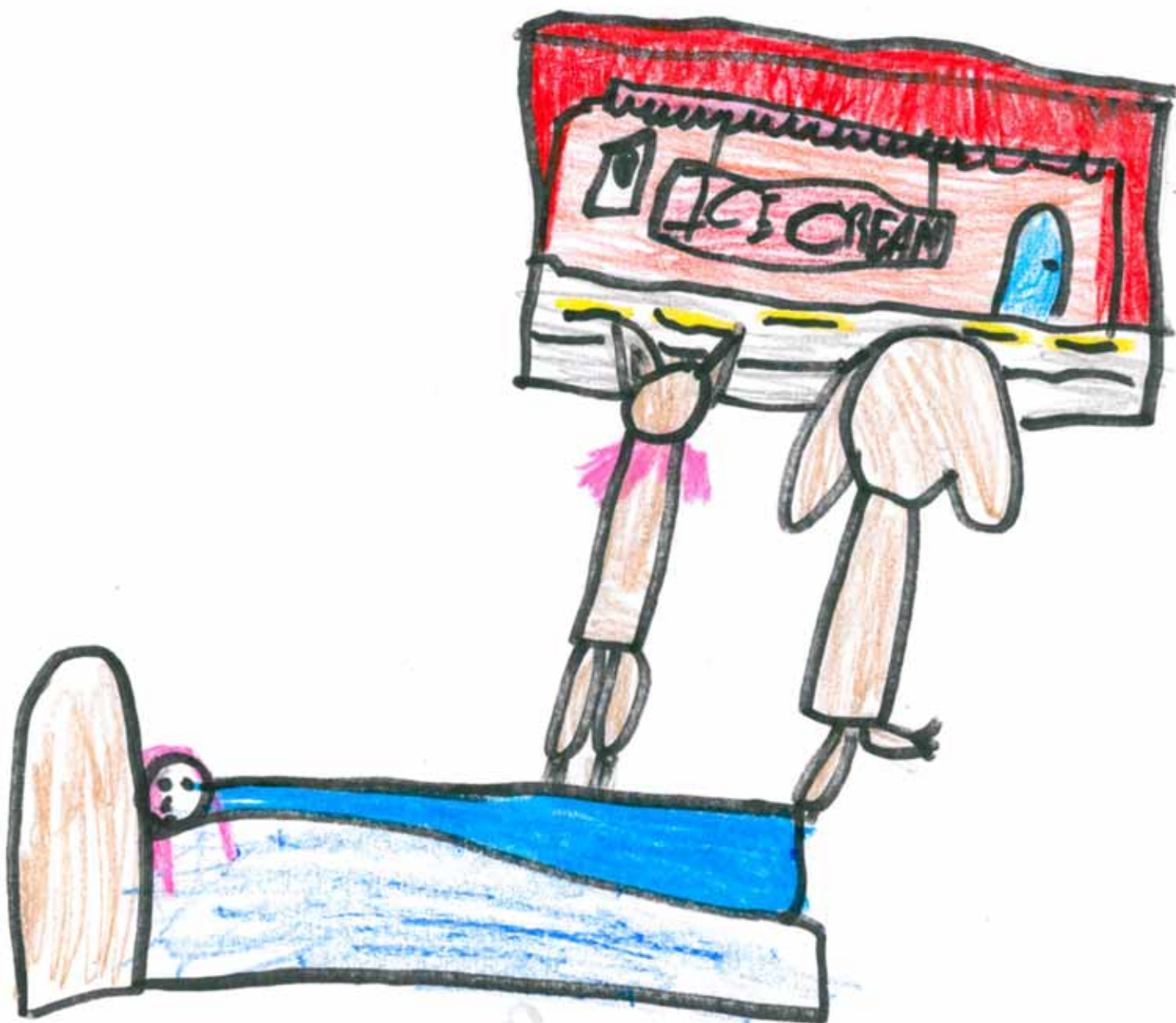

It was finally Summer. Coco and Ginger were two golden pups always going on adventures, and sometimes maybe getting into a little trouble, too.



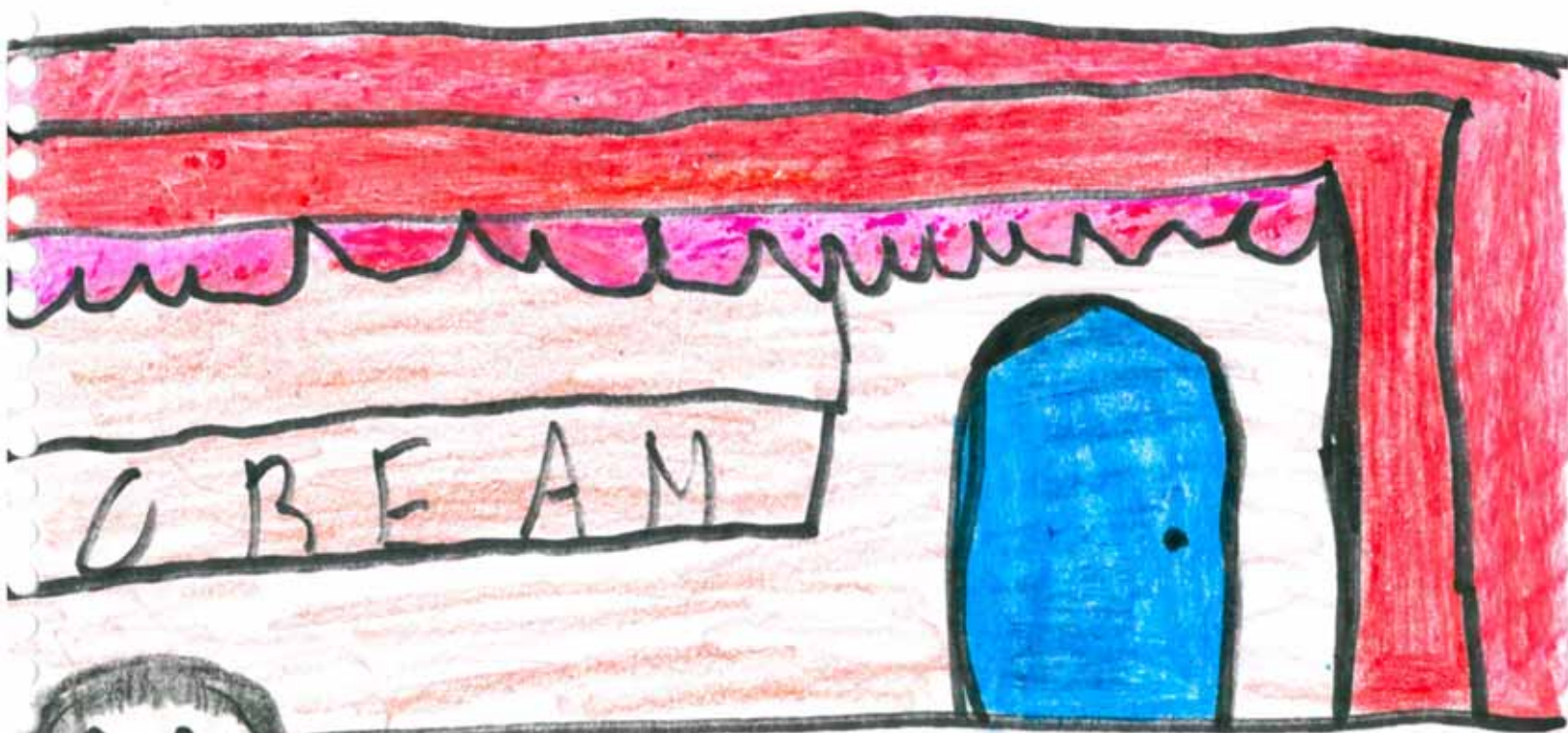

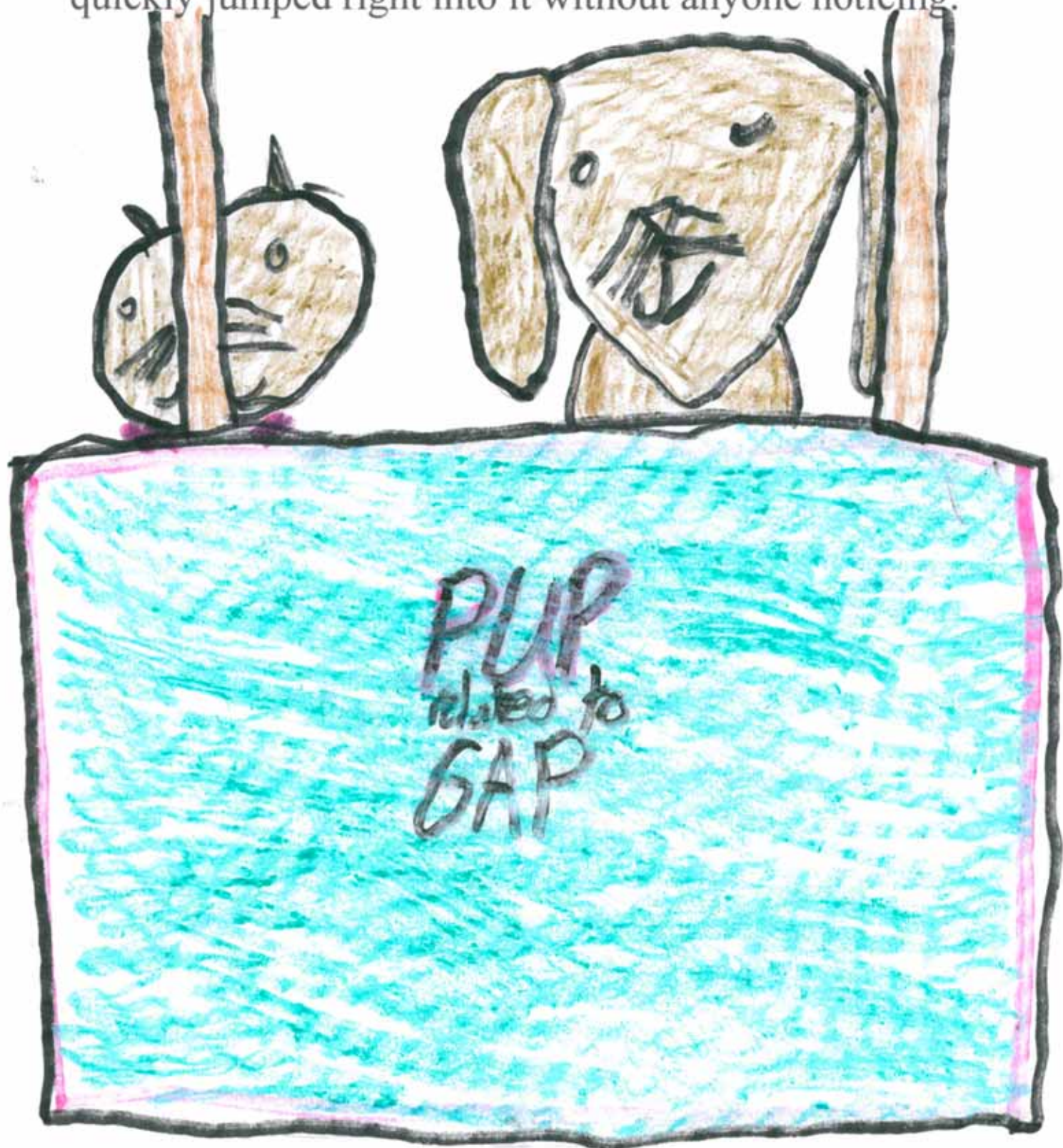
