"Good, now let's get the others!" said Carmen. "There's Peter! And May!" she yelled.

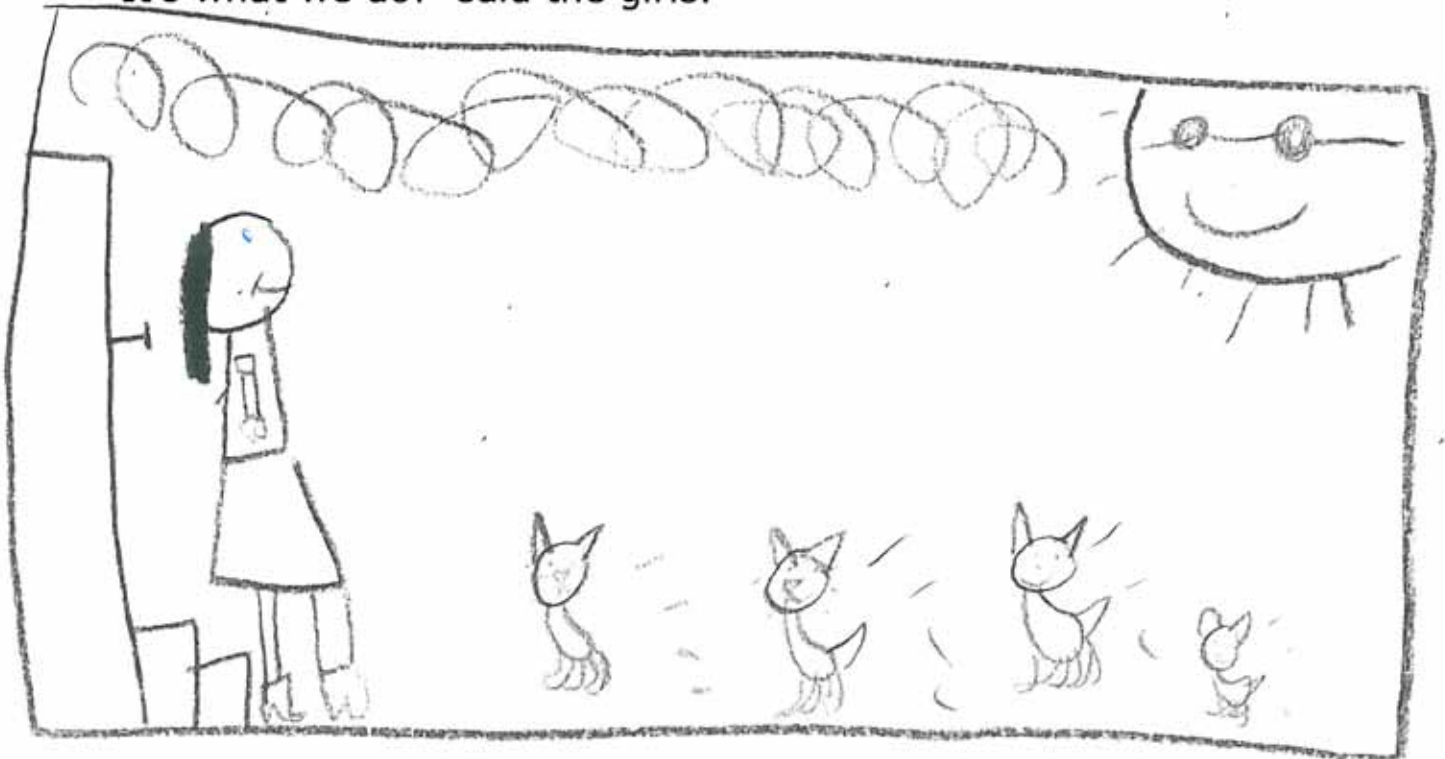
"I've got Lizzy!" called Gennie.
