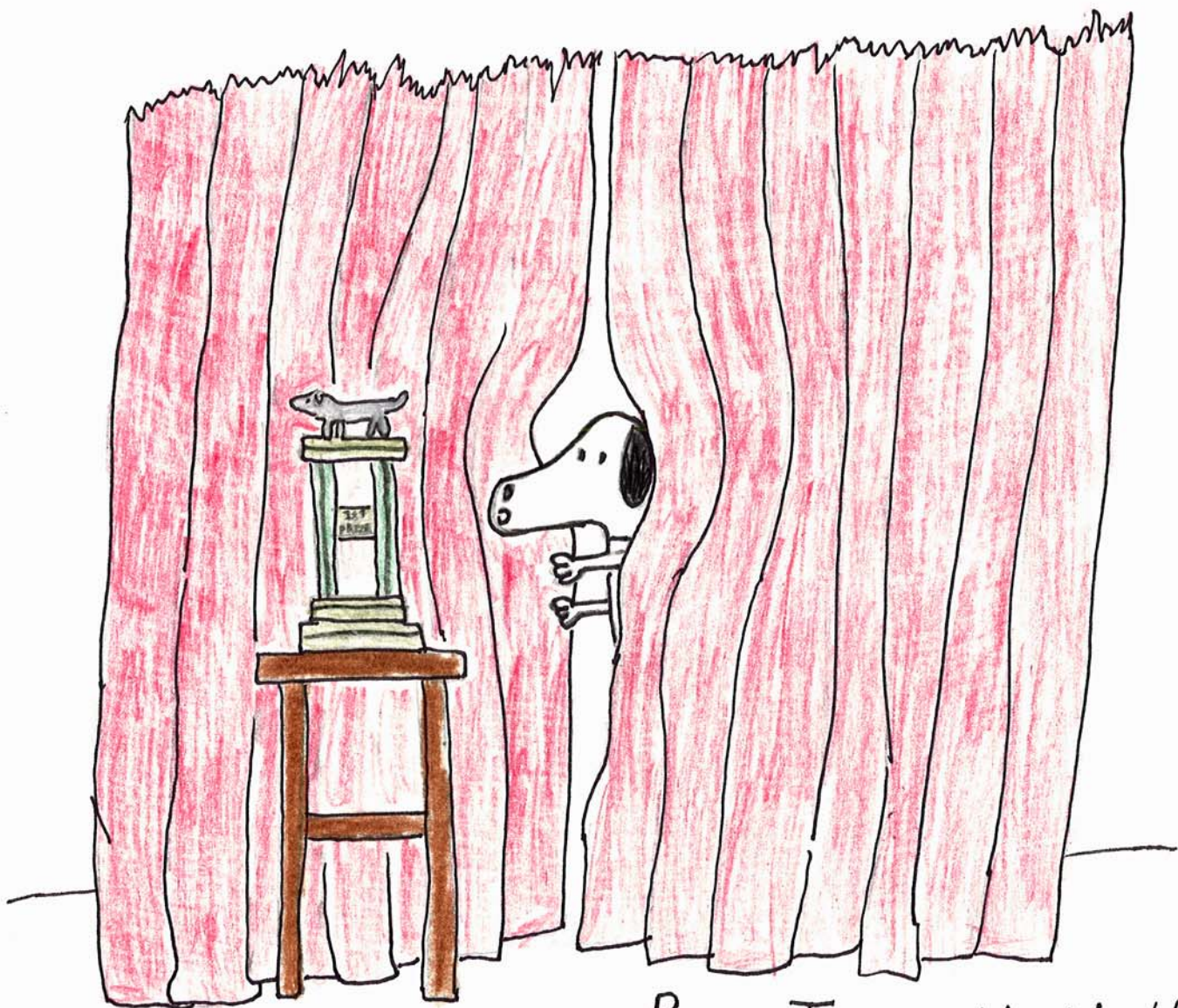

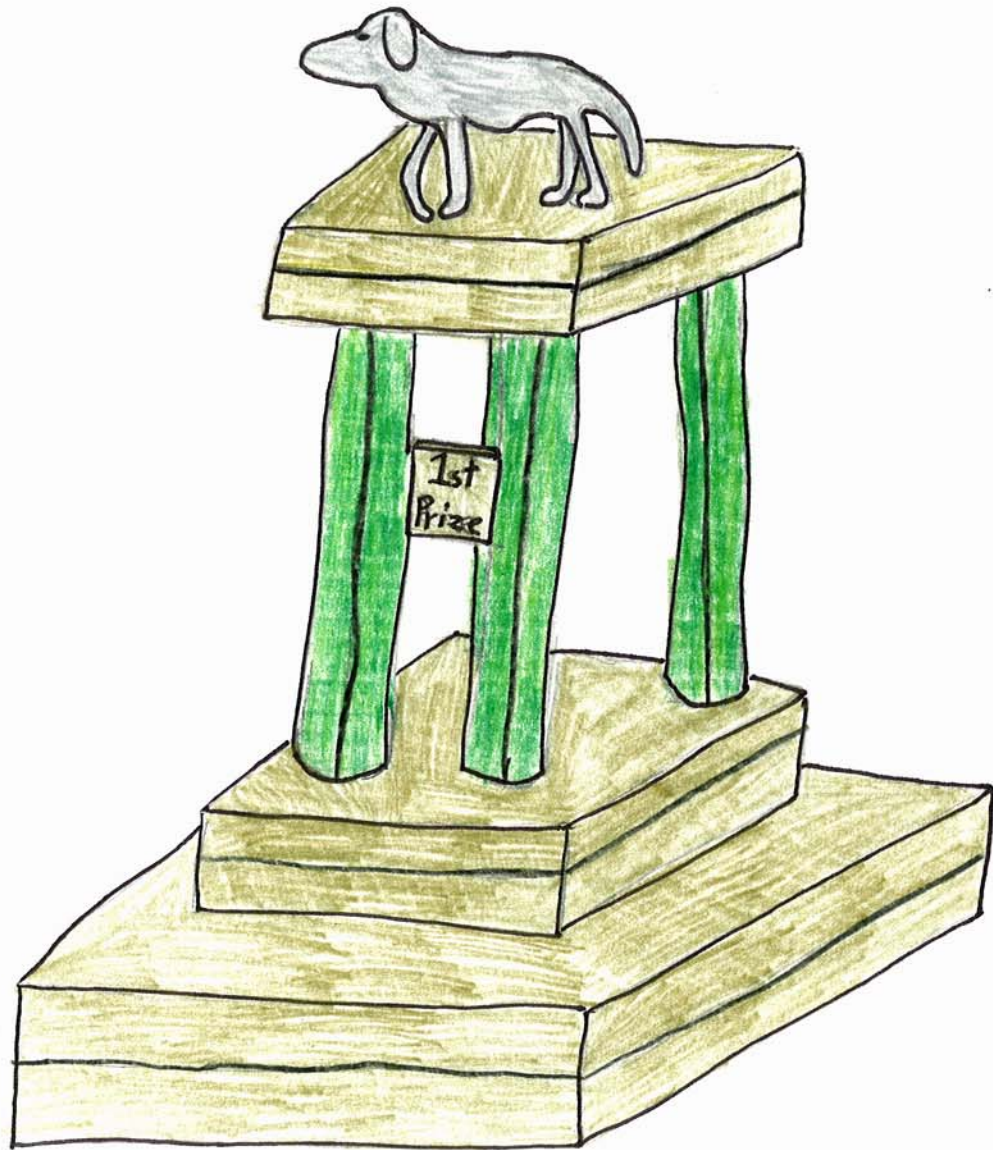

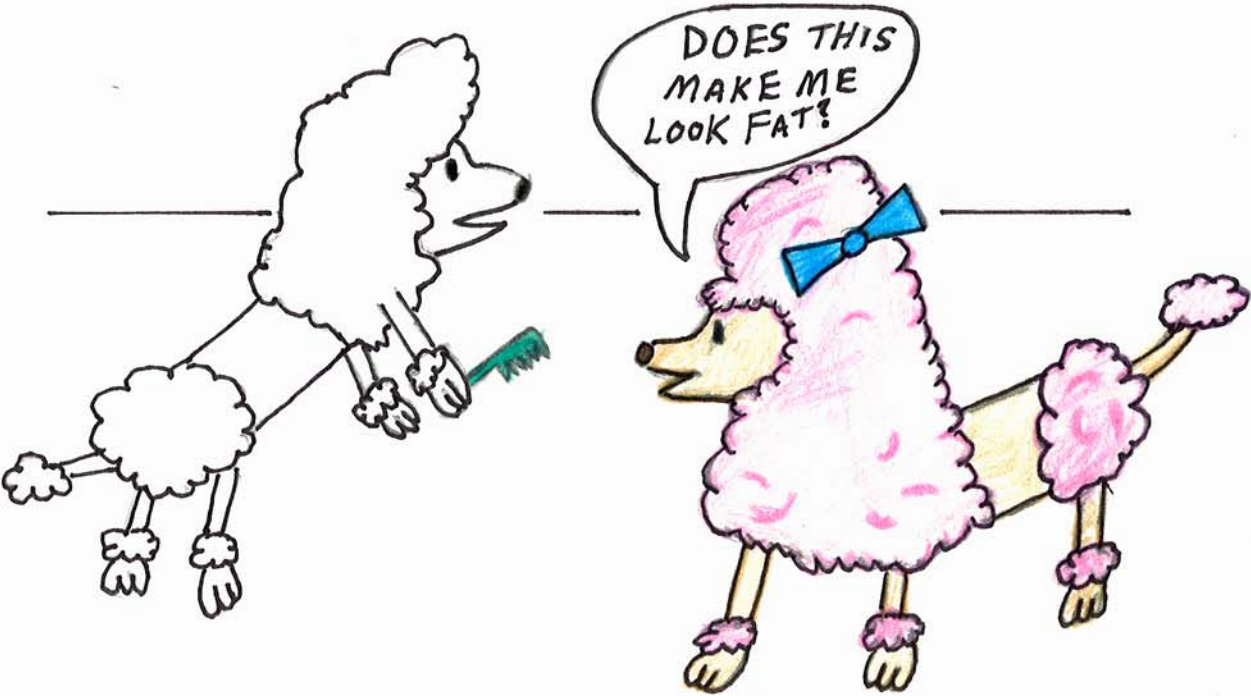


St. Bernards, known for their search and rescue missions, have a great ability to locate snacks.



And they always have something handy to wash it down!

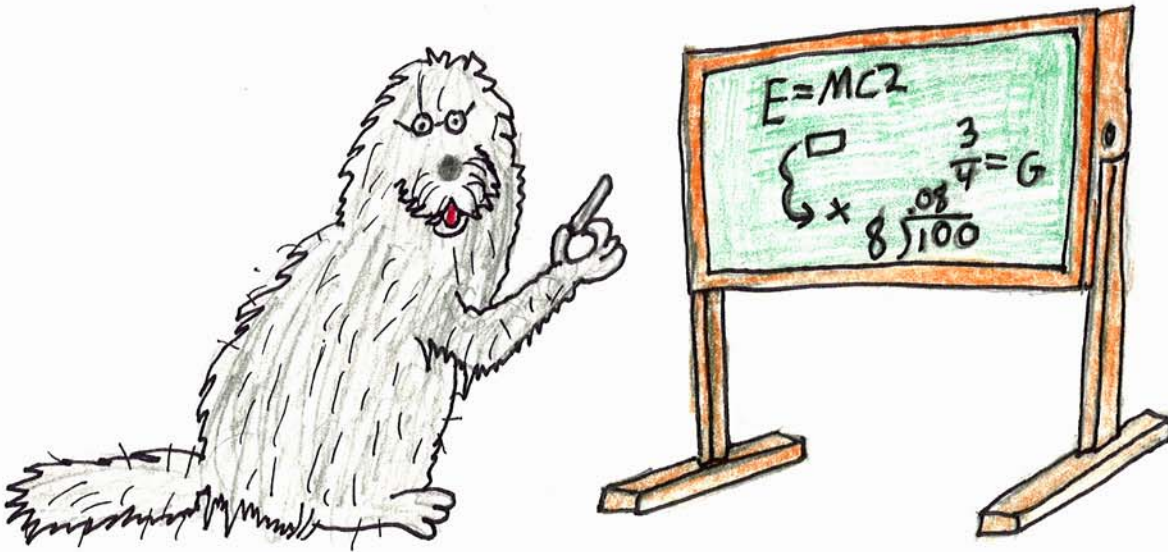
The Poodles are all obsessed with finding the perfect hair bow to show off all their poofs.



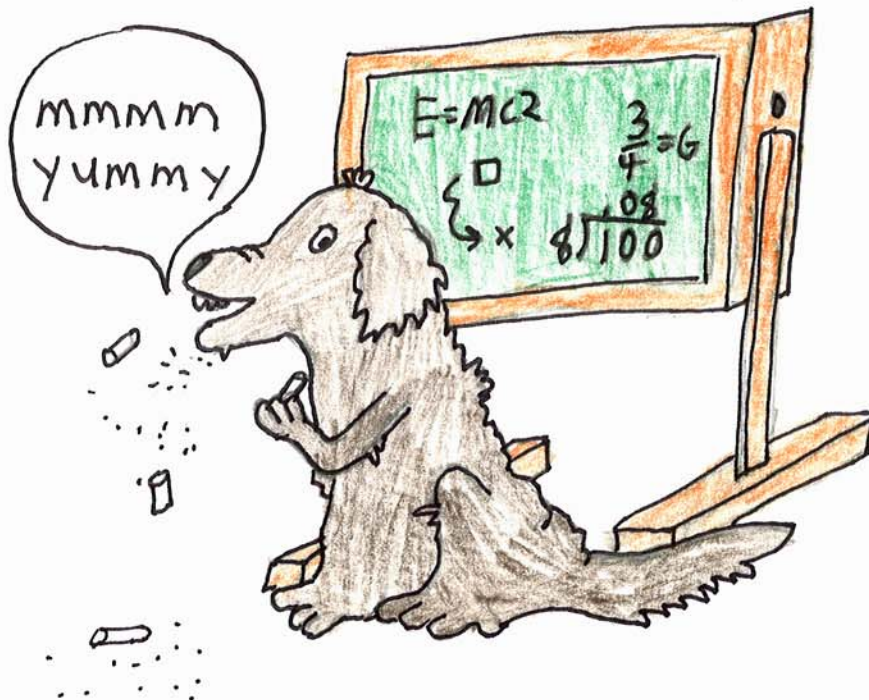


Since there are no fire trucks to chase back stage, the Dalmations settle for chasing their tails.

The not-so-smart dogs think the chalk is tasty.

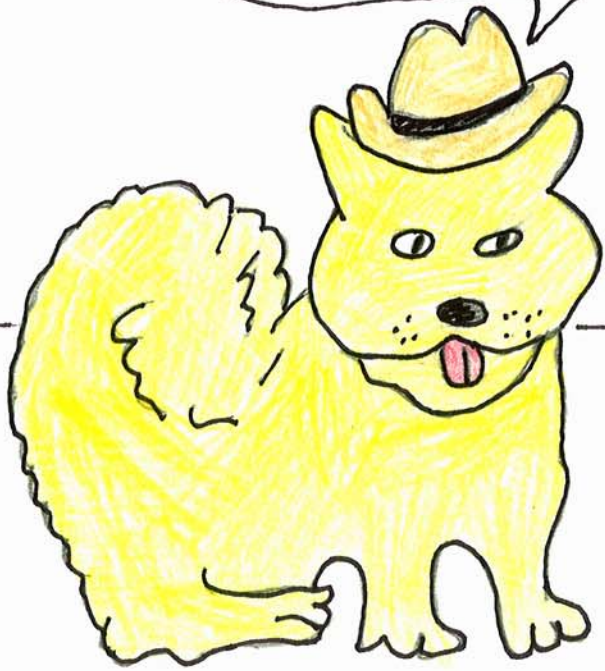


Bulldogs have a reputation for bossing the small breeds around.....and for having *really* bad breath.
