## 2025 Peoria Mayoral Primary Debate to Air on January 23

Peoria, IL – WTVP PBS, WCBU, Peoria Public Radio and part of the NPR Network, the League of Women Voters of Greater Peoria and the NAACP Peoria are proud to present the *2025 Peoria Mayoral Primary Debate* on January 23. The public will have multiple opportunities to view and listen to the hour-long debate. WCBU (89.9 FM and WCBU.org) and WTVP PBS (television channel 47.1) will both broadcast the debate on January 23 at 8pm. WCBU will re-air the debate on January 24 at 6pm.
